Monthly Meeting Minutes

April 19, 2016

In attendance: Shandrel Young, Matt Solie, Linda Springer, Stephen Quan and Diana Mason

Vice President, Stephen Quan, called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.

A sign in sheet was passed around. It was agreed that a copy of the agenda and meeting notice needs to be sent out to Council members prior to the meeting.

After discussion, a motion was made by Diana Mason to table the approval of the minutes for the March meeting and was seconded by Linda Springer. There were a lot of questions particularly about the changes requested in the February meeting minutes which did not appear or need clarification.

Upcoming Events – 6/16 Movie in the Park, 6/23 is a kids concert. The Holiday party needs to be changed to 12/17 because of the programming in the park. Ms. Young would like to see the Halloween party the week before instead of the weekend of Halloween as has been done in the past. If we have a block party in September, it cannot be the first or second week of September. Ms. Young thought the clothing or food drive as a give back to the community event was a great idea.
